

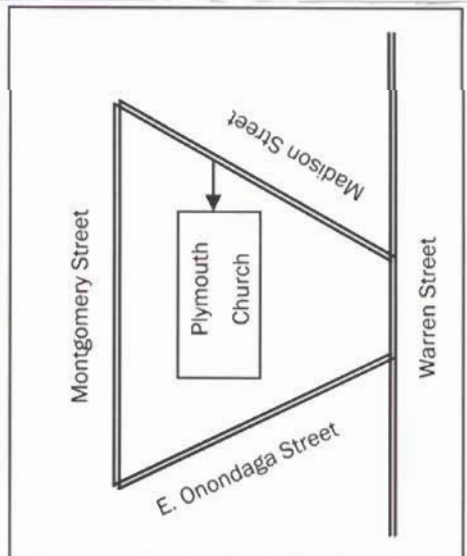
PROGRAM HOURS

LOCATION

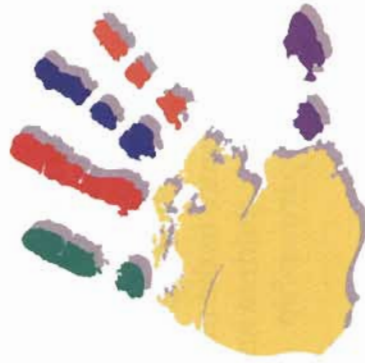

STAFF

Plymouth's staff guide and encourage learning through planning activities that are structured as well as non-structured. Activities are child directed and prepared based on what children already know and expanding on that knowledge.

All of our teachers meet or exceed the NYS Children and Family Services regulation. Teachers attend various workshops and seminars to enhance their knowledge of child development.



ENROLLMENT

Plymouth accepts children between the ages of 18 months and 12 years. All children are enrolled regardless of race, creed, national origin, economic status or handicap. The center does accept subsidy funding from various agencies.

Plymouth Day Care Center collaborates with Syracuse City School District to provide a Universal Pre-K program for all 4 year old children enrolled.
